Eligibility, Contest Rules & Fine Print

Eligibility

- Open to Canadian and U.S. residents.
- Photos must be from British Columbia's backcountry (however, the terrain does not need to be in BLBCA lodge terrain).

Contest rules

- There is a maximum of **5 entries** permitted per photographer.
- All category winners will receive a prize. Prizes must be accepted as awarded.
- All photo entries must be:
 - DPI: 300dpi minimum
 - Format: jpg
 - Max Size: 5MB
 - Longest side: 1024 pixels
- All prizes and prize packages are provided at the discretion of the Backcountry Lodges of British Columbia Association and sponsoring partners. Winners must abide by the conditions of the donated item as outlined by the sponsor.
- Entries will be accepted subject to our discretion (e.g. entries with nudity or indecency may be spammed *absolutely everywhere* across the web but will not be accepted in the contest!).
- Only original photography will be accepted.
- No entries can be manipulated in content, however, cropping is acceptable.
- The grand prize will be chosen from the category winners.
